5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 43, Penal Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 43.231 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 43.231. PROMOTION OF CHILD-LIKE SEX DOLL. (a) In this
8	section, "child-like sex doll" means an obscene, anatomically
9	correct doll, mannequin, or robot that has the features of a child
10	and that is intended to be used for sexual stimulation or
11	gratification.
12	(b) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly:
13	(1) promotes a child-like sex doll; or
14	(2) possesses, with the intent to promote, a
15	child-like sex doll.
16	(c) An offense under Subsection (b)(1) is a felony of the
17	third degree.
18	(d) An offense under Subsection (b)(2) is a Class A
19	misdemeanor.
20	(e) A person who possesses six or more child-like sex dolls
21	is presumed to possess the dolls with the intent to promote the
22	dolls.
23	(f) It is an affirmative defense to prosecution under this
24	section that the person who possesses or promotes the child-like

1 sex dolls does so for a bona fide law enforcement purpose.

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
