(a) This 9 section applies only to a county: 10 11 (1) in which a municipality with a population of 12 500,000 or more is located; and 13 (2) that is located on an international border. 14 (b) The commissioners court of a county by order may regulate the operation of a junkyard, automotive wrecking and 15 16 salvage yard, or recycling business located in the unincorporated area of the county. 17 (c) A commissioners court may not include in an order 18 adopted under this section a requirement that conflicts with a 19 similar requirement prescribed by another law governing a junkyard, 20 automotive wrecking and salvage yard, or recycling business, 21 including a requirement prescribed by Chapter 391, 396, or 397, 22 23 Transportation Code.
