	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1	AN ACT
2	relating to the recovery by the attorney general from the federal
3	government of certain border security expenditures.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 402, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 402.0211 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 402.0211. RECOVERY OF CERTAIN BORDER SECURITY
8	EXPENDITURES. (a) The attorney general shall, not later than the
9	30th day after the beginning of each state fiscal biennium:
10	(1) determine the amount of money spent by this state
11	on border security during the preceding state fiscal biennium;
12	(2) prepare an invoice requesting payment of the
13	amount determined under Subdivision (1); and
14	(3) submit the invoice prepared under Subdivision (2)
15	to the appropriate agency of the federal government for payment.
16	(b) The attorney general may request the assistance of the
17	Legislative Budget Board in making the determination required under
18	Subsection (a)(1), and the Legislative Budget Board shall provide
19	the requested assistance.
20	(c) An invoice submitted under Subsection (a)(3) must
21	include the date the invoice is due, which must be at least six, but
22	not more than eight, months after the date the invoice is submitted.
23	(d) If an invoice submitted under Subsection (a)(3) is paid
24	on or before the date the invoice is due, the attorney general shall

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1	deposit the payment in the state treasury to the credit of the
2	general revenue fund.
3	(e) If an invoice submitted under Subsection (a)(3) is not
4	timely paid, the attorney general shall bring an action against the
5	appropriate agency of the federal government to recover the amount
6	due as stated on the invoice.
7	(f) The attorney general shall deposit any money received as
8	a result of an action brought under Subsection (e) in the state
9	treasury to the credit of the general revenue fund.
10	(g) Notwithstanding any provision of Subsection (a) to the
11	contrary, for the state fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2025:
12	(1) the attorney general shall take the actions
13	described by Subsection (a) not later than March 1, 2026; and
14	(2) for purposes of Subsection (a)(1), the attorney
15	general shall determine the amount of money spent by this state on
16	border security to be the lesser of:
17	(A) the amount of money spent by this state for
18	that purpose during the period beginning September 1, 2001, and
19	ending August 31, 2025; or
20	(B) \$20 billion.
21	(h) Subsection (g) and this subsection expire August 31,
22	<u>2027.</u>
23	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 27 Act takes effect on September 1, 2025.

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
