- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 443, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 443.0134 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 443.0134. PLACE TO EXPRESS BREAST MILK. The board
- 8 shall provide a place in the Capitol, other than a bathroom, that is
- 9 shielded from view and free from intrusion of any person where a
- 10 member of the public or an employee can express breast milk.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 619.004, Government Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- Sec. 619.004. PUBLIC EMPLOYER RESPONSIBILITIES. (a) A
- 14 public employer shall:
- 15 (1) provide a reasonable amount of break time for an
- 16 employee to express breast milk each time the employee has need to
- 17 express the milk; and
- 18 (2) provide a place, other than a [multiple user]
- 19 bathroom, that is shielded from view and free from intrusion from
- 20 other employees and the public where the employee can express
- 21 breast milk.
- (b) A public employer that engages in or contracts for the
- 23 construction or renovation of any building regularly occupied by
- 24 members of the public shall ensure the building includes a publicly

- 1 accessible place, other than a bathroom, that is shielded from view
- 2 and free from intrusion of another person where a member of the
- 3 public can express breast milk.
- 4 SECTION 3. Subchapter Z, Chapter 661, Government Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Section 661.925 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 661.925. LEAVE FOR BREAST MILK DONORS. (a) A state
- 7 agency shall allow each agency employee sufficient time off,
- 8 without a deduction in salary or accrued leave, to donate breast
- 9 milk.
- 10 (b) An employee may not receive time off under this section
- 11 unless the employee obtains approval from the employee's supervisor
- 12 before taking time off.
- 13 <u>(c) An employee may receive time off under this section once</u>
- 14 a month.
- SECTION 4. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 16 of this Act, the State Preservation Board shall establish a place in
- 17 the Capitol for a person to express breast milk as required by
- 18 Section 443.0134, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 19 SECTION 5. Section 619.004(b), Government Code, as added by
- 20 this Act, applies only to the construction or renovation of a
- 21 building described by that section that begins on or after the
- 22 effective date of this Act.
- 23 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
