## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a matching grant program for technological enhancements
3	at hospitals providing mental health care services.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 547, Government Code, as effective April
6	1, 2025, is amended by adding Subchapter K to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER K. MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM FOR TECHNOLOGICAL
8	ENHANCEMENTS AT HOSPITALS PROVIDING MENTAL HEALTH CARE SERVICES
9	Sec. 547.0501. APPLICABILITY. This subchapter applies only
10	<u>to:</u>
11	(1) a hospital licensed under Chapter 241, Health and
12	Safety Code; or
13	(2) a hospital licensed under Chapter 577, Health and
14	Safety Code.
15	Sec. 547.0502. ESTABLISHMENT OF MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM.
16	The commission shall establish a matching grant program to enhance
17	the technological capabilities of hospitals providing mental
18	health care services in this state.
19	Sec. 547.0503. ELIGIBILITY FOR GRANT AWARD. To be eligible
20	for a grant under this subchapter, a hospital must:
21	(1) demonstrate the hospital's planned uses for the
22	grant money and matching funds to improve the quality of and access
23	to mental health care services in this state;
24	(2) align with the interoperability and technology

- 1 standards in the 21st Century Cures Act (Pub. L. No. 114-255); and
- 2 (3) meet any additional eligibility criteria the
- 3 commission establishes.
- 4 Sec. 547.0504. HOSPITAL MATCHING REQUIREMENT. (a) The
- 5 commission shall condition each grant provided to a hospital under
- 6 this subchapter on the hospital providing funds from non-state
- 7 sources in an amount equal to 25 percent of the grant amount.
- 8 (b) To raise the required non-state sourced funds, the
- 9 hospital may seek and receive gifts, grants, or donations from any
- 10 person.
- Sec. 547.0505. ACCEPTABLE USES OF GRANT MONEY AND MATCHING
- 12 FUNDS. A hospital awarded a grant under this subchapter may use the
- 13 grant money and matching funds to:
- 14 (1) purchase a data recording platform for certified
- 15 <u>electronic health data;</u>
- 16 (2) expand the interoperability of health information
- 17 in the hospital or as part of a network with other health care
- 18 providers;
- 19 (3) expand a patient's access to the patient's digital
- 20 health records and mental health care services;
- 21 (4) improve information technology infrastructure for
- 22 data privacy and patient information security, including consent
- 23 management; and
- 24 (5) improve the efficiency of mental health care
- 25 service provision through the use and interconnectivity of mobile
- 26 devices.
- Sec. 547.0506. GIFTS, GRANTS, AND DONATIONS. The

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- 1 commission may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and donations from
- 2 any source to award grants under this subchapter.
- 3 Sec. 547.0507. BIENNIAL REPORT. Not later than December 1
- 4 of each even-numbered year, the commission shall submit a report to
- 5 the legislature regarding the results of the matching grant program
- 6 administered under this subchapter.
- 7 Sec. 547.0508. RULES. The commission may adopt any rules
- 8 <u>necessary to implement this subchapter.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
