- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 544.002, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (c) A local authority may not place or maintain a
- 9 traffic-control device on a highway under the jurisdiction of the
- 10 Texas Department of Transportation without that department's
- 11 permission, except as authorized under <u>Subsection (d) and Section</u>
- 12 545.3561.
- 13 <u>(d) A local authority may place and maintain a temporary</u>
- 14 traffic-control device on a highway under the jurisdiction of the
- 15 Texas Department of Transportation without the department's
- 16 permission if:
- 17 (1) an existing traffic-control device on the highway
- 18 <u>becomes inoperable;</u>
- 19 (2) the local authority notifies the department of the
- 20 placement of the temporary traffic-control device; and
- 21 (3) the local authority removes the temporary
- 22 traffic-control device as soon as practicable after the existing
- 23 traffic-control device becomes operable again.
- SECTION 2. Section 553.002(d), Transportation Code, is

- 2 (d) This section does not apply to:
- $\underline{\text{(1)}}$  an ordinance enacted or a temporary speed limit
- 4 sign erected or operated under Section 545.3561; or
- 5 (2) an ordinance enacted or a temporary
- 6 traffic-control device placed or maintained under Section
- 7 <u>544.002(d)</u>.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
