## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to authorizing certain cities to change the date on which
- 3 their general election for officers is held.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 41.0052(f), Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (f) The governing body of a city with a population of 9,000
- 8 or less, located predominantly in a county that has a total area of
- 9 less than 6,200 [4,800] square miles, that has adopted a
- 10 council-manager form of government and that holds its general
- 11 election for officers on a date other than the November uniform
- 12 election date may, not later than December 31, 2026 [2024], change
- 13 the date on which it holds its general election for officers to the
- 14 November uniform election date. Subsections (b), (c), and (d)
- 15 apply to the change of an election date under this
- 16 subsection. This subsection expires January 1, 2027 [2025].
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
