## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

Τ	AN ACT	
2	relating to emergency detention by a paramedic of certain persons	
3	with mental illness for preliminary examination at a mental health	
4	facility.	
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:	
6	SECTION 1. Section 573.0001, Health and Safety Code, is	
7	amended by adding Subdivisions (3) and (4) to read as follows:	
8	(3) "Medical director" means a licensed physician who	
9	supervises the provision of emergency medical services by a public	
10	or private entity that:	
11	(A) provides those services; and	
12	(B) employs one or more paramedics.	
13	(4) "Paramedic" means a person licensed under Chapter	
14	773 as a licensed paramedic.	
15	SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 573, Health and Safety	
16	Code, is amended by adding Sections 573.006 and 573.007 to read as	
17	follows:	
18	Sec. 573.006. DETENTION BY PARAMEDIC FOR PRELIMINARY	
19	EXAMINATION. (a) A paramedic may detain a person for preliminary	
20	examination under Section 573.021 at a mental health facility,	
21	regardless of the person's age, if the paramedic:	
22	(1) is specifically authorized to detain a person	
23	under this subsection by the medical director for the entity that	
24	employs or contracts with the paramedic;	

1	(2) has reason to believe and does believe that:	
2	(A) the person is a person with mental illness;	
3	<u>and</u>	
4	(B) because of that mental illness there is a	
5	substantial risk of serious harm to the person or others unless the	
6	person is immediately restrained; and	
7	(3) believes that there is not sufficient time to	
8	obtain a warrant or for a peace officer to take the person into	
9	custody.	
10	(b) A substantial risk of serious harm to the person or	
11	others under Subsection (a)(2)(B) may be demonstrated by:	
12	(1) the person's behavior; or	
13	(2) evidence of severe emotional distress and	
14	deterioration in the person's mental condition to the extent that	
15	the person cannot remain at liberty.	
16	(c) The paramedic may form the belief that the person meets	
17	the criteria for detention under this section based on:	
18	(1) a representation made by a credible person; or	
19	(2) the conduct of the detained person or the	
20	circumstances under which the person is detained.	
21	(d) A paramedic who detains a person under Subsection (a)	
22	shall immediately transport the detained person to:	
23	(1) the nearest appropriate inpatient mental health	
24	<pre>facility; or</pre>	
25	(2) a mental health facility deemed suitable by the	
26	local mental health authority, if an appropriate inpatient mental	
27	health facility is not available	

- 1 (e) A paramedic who detains a person under Subsection (a) at
- 2 a mental health facility described by Subsection (d)(1) or (2)
- 3 shall immediately inform the person orally in simple, nontechnical
- 4 terms:
- 5 <u>(1) of the reason for the detention; and</u>
- 6 (2) that a staff member of the facility will inform the
- 7 person of the person's rights within 24 hours after the time the
- 8 person is admitted to the facility, as provided by Section
- 9 573.025(b).
- Sec. 573.007. PARAMEDIC'S NOTIFICATION OF DETENTION. (a)
- 11 A paramedic shall immediately file with a mental health facility a
- 12 notification of detention after transporting a person to that
- 13 facility in accordance with Section 573.006.
- 14 (b) The paramedic's notification of detention must contain:
- 15 (1) a statement that the paramedic has reason to
- 16 believe and does believe that the person evidences mental illness;
- 17 (2) a statement that the paramedic has reason to
- 18 believe and does believe that the person evidences a substantial
- 19 risk of serious harm to the person or others;
- 20 (3) a specific description of the risk of harm;
- 21 (4) a statement that the paramedic has reason to
- 22 believe and does believe that the risk of harm is imminent unless
- 23 the person is immediately restrained;
- 24 (5) a statement that the paramedic's beliefs are
- 25 derived from specific recent behavior, overt acts, attempts, or
- 26 threats that were observed by or reliably reported to the
- 27 paramedic;

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1	(6) a detailed description of the specific behavior,			
2	acts, attempts, or threats; and			
3	(7) the name and relationship to the detained person			
4	of any person who reported or observed the behavior, acts,			
5	attempts, or threats.			
6	(c) The mental health facility where the person is detained			
7	shall include in the detained person's clinical file the			
8	notification of detention described by this section.			
9	(d) The paramedic shall provide the notification of			
10	detention on the following form:

- 4 A mental health facility or hospital emergency department may not
- 5 require a paramedic to execute any form other than this form as a
- 6 predicate to accepting for temporary admission a person detained by
- 7 <u>a paramedic under Section 573.006, Health and Safety Code, and</u>
- 8 transported by the paramedic under that section.
- 9 (e) A mental health facility or hospital emergency
- 10 department may not require a paramedic to execute any form other
- 11 than the form provided by Subsection (d) as a predicate to accepting
- 12 for temporary admission a person detained by a paramedic under
- 13 Section 573.006 and transported by the paramedic under that
- 14 section.
- SECTION 3. Section 573.021(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 (a) A facility shall temporarily accept and detain a person
- 18 for whom:
- 19 (1) an application for detention is filed;
- 20 (2) [or for whom] a peace officer or emergency medical
- 21 services personnel of an emergency medical services provider
- 22 transporting the person in accordance with a memorandum of
- 23 understanding executed under Section 573.005 files a notification
- 24 of detention completed by the peace officer under Section
- 25 573.002(a); or
- 26 (3) a paramedic detaining and transporting the person
- 27 under Section 573.006 files a notification of detention under

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## 1 <u>Section 573.007</u>.

- 2 SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 3 an emergency detention that begins on or after the effective date of
- 4 this Act. An emergency detention that begins before the effective
- 5 date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately
- 6 before that date, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 7 purpose.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
