- 5 SECTION 1. Section 233.061(b), Local Government Code, is 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The commissioners court of a county that adopts a fire
- 8 code under Subsection (a) [, or any municipality in the county,] may
- 9 contract with a municipality located in the county or an emergency
- 10 <u>services district located wholly in the county</u> [one another] for
- 11 the administration and enforcement of the fire code.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 352.019, Local Government Code, is
- 13 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to
- 14 read as follows:
- 15 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (a-1), the [The] county
- 16 fire marshal shall enforce all state and county regulations that
- 17 relate to fires, explosions, or damages of any kind caused by a fire
- 18 or explosion.
- 19 (a-1) The county fire marshal shall delegate the
- 20 administration and enforcement of the county's fire code to a
- 21 municipality or emergency services district in accordance with a
- 22 contract entered into by the commissioners court of the county
- 23 under Section 233.061.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
