A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2	relating to a parent's right to be notified by a school district
3	concerning acts of self-harm by the parent's child.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 26, Education Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 26.0083 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 26.0083. PARENTAL NOTIFICATION CONCERNING ACTS OF
8	SELF-HARM BY PARENT'S CHILD. (a) In this section, "self-harm"
9	includes:
10	(1) attempted suicide;
11	(2) the expression of suicidal ideation;
12	(3) the intentional ingestion of toxins;
13	(4) hitting, cutting, or burning oneself, or engaging
14	in other acts of self-mutilation;
15	(5) engaging in high-risk sexual behavior;
16	(6) altering one's biological sex;
17	(7) abusing drugs or alcohol; and
18	(8) engaging in any other behavior that causes
19	self-injury.
20	(b) A school district shall immediately notify a parent if
21	the parent's child engages in or expresses a desire to engage in an
22	act of self-harm, or otherwise indicates by words or behavior a
23	likelihood of engaging in an act of self-harm, including words or
24	behavior expressing gender dysphoria or other distress relating to

- 1 the child's biological sex.
- 2 (c) An employee of a school district who witnesses a child
- 3 engage in an act, expression, or behavior described by Subsection
- 4 (b) shall immediately inform an appropriate district
- 5 administrator.
- 6 (d) A school district employee who fails to comply with
- 7 <u>Subsection (c) may be subject to, as applicable:</u>
- 8 (1) discharge or suspension without pay under Section
- 9 21.104 or 21.156; or
- 10 (2) termination or suspension under Section 21.211.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 12 school year.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
