- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 57.002(d), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (d) Subject to Subsection (e), in a county with a population
- 8 of 50,000 or more, a court may appoint a spoken language interpreter
- 9 who is not a certified or licensed court interpreter:
- 10 (1) if:
- 11 $\underline{\text{(A)}}$ [\frac{(A)}{2}] the language necessary in the
- 12 proceeding is a language other than Spanish; and
- 13 $\underline{\text{(B)}}$ [$\frac{\text{(2)}}{\text{)}}$] the court makes a finding that there is
- 14 no licensed court interpreter within 75 miles who can interpret in
- 15 the language that is necessary in a proceeding; or
- 16 (2) if the court is a justice court, municipal court,
- 17 <u>or municipal court of record</u>.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
