- Criminal Procedure. 15 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to a court order relating to an offense for which Section 22.011(e)(2), Penal Code, would 16 have provided an affirmative defense if the defendant had committed 17 the offense:
- (1) in this state; and 19
- 20 (2) on or after September 1, 2025.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 521.1231, Transportation Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a driver's license issued or renewed on 22 or after the effective date of this Act. A driver's license issued 23 or renewed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the 24

- 1 law in effect when the license was issued or renewed, and the former
- 2 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
