L AN ACT

- 2 relating to information regarding the procedures and available
- 3 resources for the sealing of juvenile records.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 58.262, Family Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsections (a-1),
- 7 (b-1), and (e) to read as follows:
- 8 (a) When a child is referred to the juvenile probation
- 9 department, an employee of the juvenile probation department shall
- 10 give the child and the child's parent, guardian, or custodian:
- 11 (1) a written explanation describing the process of
- 12 sealing records under this subchapter and a copy of this
- 13 subchapter; and
- 14 (2) a list of local resources that may assist the child
- 15 in applying to have the child's records sealed, including attorneys
- 16 who, at low or no cost, represent persons in applying for the
- 17 sealing of juvenile records.
- 18 <u>(a-1)</u> At the time an employee of the juvenile probation
- 19 department gives a written explanation under Subsection (a), the
- 20 employee shall additionally provide an oral explanation of the
- 21 process of sealing records to the child and the child's parent,
- 22 guardian, or custodian and allow any of those persons to ask
- 23 questions regarding the process.
- (b) On the final discharge of a child, or on the last

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- 1 official action in the matter if there is no adjudication, a
- 2 probation officer, other official at the juvenile probation
- 3 department, or official at the Texas Juvenile Justice Department,
- 4 as appropriate, shall give the child and the child's parent,
- 5 guardian, or custodian:
- 6 (1) a written explanation regarding the eligibility of
- 7 the child's records for sealing under this subchapter and a copy of
- 8 this subchapter; and
- 9 (2) a list of local resources that may assist the child
- 10 in applying to have the child's records sealed, including attorneys
- 11 who, at low or no cost, represent persons in applying for the
- 12 <u>sealing of juvenile records</u>.
- 13 (b-1) At the time a probation officer, other official at the
- 14 juvenile probation department, or official at the Texas Juvenile
- 15 Justice Department gives a written explanation under Subsection
- 16 (b), the officer or official shall additionally provide an oral
- 17 explanation of the eligibility of the child's records for sealing
- 18 to the child and the child's parent, guardian, or custodian and
- 19 allow any of those persons to ask questions regarding the child's
- 20 eligibility and the process of having records sealed.
- 21 <u>(e) The Texas Juvenile Justice Department shall publish on</u>
- 22 the department's Internet website a brochure that describes the
- 23 process of sealing records under this subchapter and that lists
- 24 resources that may assist a child in applying to seal the child's
- 25 records.
- 26 SECTION 2. Subchapter C-1, Chapter 58, Family Code, is
- 27 amended by adding Section 58.2625 to read as follows:

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- 1 Sec. 58.2625. ONLINE DIRECTORY OF ATTORNEYS FOR SEALING
- 2 JUVENILE RECORDS. (a) In this section, "state bar" means the State
- 3 Bar of Texas.
- 4 (b) The state bar shall create and maintain a directory of
- 5 attorneys in this state who, at low or no cost, represent persons in
- 6 applying for the sealing of juvenile records. The directory must
- 7 describe the administrative judicial regions created under Section
- 8 74.042, Government Code, and list the attorneys who offer that
- 9 representation in those regions.
- 10 (c) The state bar shall make the directory available to the
- 11 public on the state bar's Internet website.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
