- 8 (d) A commissioned law enforcement officer of the National
- 9 Park Service is not a peace officer under the laws of this state but

- 11 (1) the powers of arrest, search, and seizure as to any
- 12 offense under the laws of this state committed in a national park or
- 13 national recreation area;
- 14 (2) the power to execute any arrest warrant or search
- 15 warrant issued under the laws of this state; and
- 16 (3) the powers granted to a peace officer by Chapters
- 17 573 and 574, Health and Safety Code.
- 18 <u>(d-1)</u> For purposes of Subsection (d) [In this subsection],
- 19 "national park or national recreation area" means a national park
- 20 or national recreation area included in the National Park System as
- 21 defined by 54 U.S.C. Section 100102.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
