3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 544, Transportation Code, is amended by
5	adding Section 544.014 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 544.014. CROSSWALK MARKING REQUIREMENTS. (a)
7	Notwithstanding any other law, a local authority shall indicate a
8	marked crosswalk with one of the following:
9	(1) solid white lines that are longitudinal,
10	transverse, or diagonal; or
11	(2) a Texas-themed mural described by Subsection (b).
12	(b) A Texas-themed mural authorized by Subsection (a)(2)
13	must:
14	(1) completely fill the boundaries of the marked
15	<pre>crosswalk;</pre>
16	(2) have a white, black, or unpainted background; and
17	(3) feature the shape of the State of Texas, painted in
18	the manner of the Texas flag.
19	(c) A municipality with a population of 100,000 or more
20	shall identify the five intersections that are most used by
21	pedestrians in the municipality and indicate each marked crosswalk
22	in those intersections with a Texas-themed mural described by
23	Subsection (b).
24	SECTION 2. (a) Notwithstanding Section 544.014(c),

- 1 Transportation Code, as added by this Act, a municipality is not
- 2 required to comply with that subsection until September 1, 2027.
- 3 (b) Not later than September 1, 2027, each municipality with
- 4 a population of 100,000 or more shall conduct a study to identify
- 5 the five intersections that are most used by pedestrians in the
- 6 municipality.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
