H.B. No. 1991

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to information regarding certain charges for services provided by municipally owned utility systems.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 1502.057, Government Code, is amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

(d) A municipality that imposes operating, maintenance, replacement, or improvement charges under Subsection (a) shall:

(1) publish the amounts of the charges on the utility system's and the municipality's Internet websites; and

(2) submit the amounts of the charges to the secretary of state for publication in the Texas Register.

SECTION 2. Section 2002.011, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2002.011. TEXAS REGISTER. The secretary of state shall compile, index, cross-index to statute, and publish a publication to be known as the Texas Register. The register shall contain:

(1) notices of proposed rules issued and filed in the office of the secretary of state as provided by Subchapter B of Chapter 2001;

(2) the text of rules adopted and filed in the office of the secretary of state;

(3) notices of open meetings issued and filed in the

1 office of the secretary of state as provided by law;

2 (4) executive orders issued by the governor;

3 (5) summaries of requests for opinions of the attorney  
4 general and of the Texas Ethics Commission;

5 (6) summaries of opinions of the attorney general and  
6 of the Texas Ethics Commission;

7 (7) guidelines prepared by the attorney general under  
8 Section 2007.041;

9 (8) notices relating to the preparation of takings  
10 impact assessments as provided by Section 2007.043; ~~and~~

11 (9) other information of general interest to the  
12 public of this state, including:

13 (A) federal legislation or regulations affecting  
14 the state or a state agency; and

15 (B) state agency organizational and personnel  
16 changes; and

17 (10) the amounts of any charges submitted to the  
18 secretary of state under Section 1502.057(d).

19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
