3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2154.202, Occupations Code, is amended
5	by amending Subsections (g) and (h) to read as follows:
6	(g) [Except as provided by Subsection (h), \underline{A} [a] retail
7	fireworks permit holder may sell fireworks only to the public, and
8	only during periods:
9	(1) beginning June 24 and ending at midnight on July 4;
10	(2) beginning December 20 and ending at midnight on
11	January 1 of the following year; [and]
12	(3) beginning May 1 and ending at midnight on May 5 [$\frac{if}{i}$
13	the fireworks are sold at a location that is not more than 100 miles
14	from the Texas-Mexico border and that is in a county in which the
15	commissioners court of the county has approved the sale of
16	fireworks during the period.;
17	[(h) In addition to the periods during which the sale of
18	fireworks is authorized under Subsection (g), the commissioners
19	court of a county by order may allow a retail fireworks permit
20	holder to sell fireworks in that county only to the public and only
21	during one or more of the following periods:
22	(4) [(1)] beginning February 25 and ending at midnight
23	on March 2;
24	(5) $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$ beginning April 16 and ending at midnight on

- 1 April 21;
- (6) [(3)] beginning the Wednesday before the last
- 3 Monday in May and ending at midnight on the last Monday in May; and
- 4 (7) [(4)] beginning five days before the first day of
- 5 Diwali and ending at midnight on the last day of Diwali.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
