- 2 (h-1) If the executive director denies the application, the
- 3 executive director shall state the reasons for the denial and any
- 4 modifications to the application that are necessary for the

- 6 SECTION 2. Section 382.05199, Health and Safety Code, as
- 7 amended by this Act, applies only to an application for an
- 8 authorization to use a permit that is filed with the Texas
- 9 Commission on Environmental Quality on or after the effective date
- 10 of this Act. An application for an authorization to use a permit
- 11 filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law
- 12 in effect on the date of filing, and that law is continued in effect
- 13 for that purpose.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
