- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter H, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
- amended by adding Section 552.328 to read as follows: 6
- Sec. 552.328. CIVIL CAUSE OF ACTION. (a) In addition to 7
- the other civil actions provided by this subchapter, a requestor 8
- may bring a civil action for damages against a governmental body 9
- that violates this chapter. 10
- 11 (b) A requestor who prevails in an action brought under this
- 12 section is entitled to obtain:
- 13 (1) exemplary damages in an amount not to exceed
- \$200,000 for each violation; and 14
- 15 (2) reasonable attorney's fees and court costs.
- (c) Sovereign immunity of this state and governmental 16
- immunity of a local entity to suit and from liability is waived to 17
- the extent of liability created by this section. 18
- SECTION 2. Section 552.328, Government Code, as added by 19
- this Act, applies only to a violation of Chapter 552, Government 20
- Code, relating to a request for information that is received by a 21
- governmental body or an officer for public information on or after 22
- 23 the effective date of this Act.
- 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
