## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

 AN ACT

- 2 relating to release of an area from a municipality's

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.101, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subdivisions (1), (4), and (5) and adding
- 7 Subdivision (6) to read as follows:
- 8 (1) within [five] fifteen miles of the boundary of a
- 9 military base, as defined by Section 43.0117, at which an active
- 10 training program is conducted;
- 11 (4) in an area designated as an industrial district
- 12 under Subsection 42.044; [or]
- 13 (5) in an area subject to a strategic partnership
- 14 agreement entered into under Section 43.0751, or any other
- 15 agreement, including a development agreement entered into under
- 16 Section 212.172; or [→]
- 17 (6) in an area within a municipality's certificate of
- 18 convenience and necessity issued in accordance with Chapter 13,
- 19 <u>Subchapter G, Water Code.</u>
- 20 SECTION 2. Section 42.151, Local Government Code, is
- 21 amended by amending Subdivisions (1), (4), and (5) and adding
- 22 Subdivision (6) to read as follows:
- 23 (1) within [five] fifteen miles of the boundary of a
- 24 military base, as defined by Section 43.0117, at which an active

- 1 training program is conducted;
- 2 (4) in an area designated as an industrial district
- 3 under Section 42.044; [ex]
- 4 (5) in an area subject to a strategic partnership
- 5 agreement entered into under Section 43.0751, or any other
- 6 agreement, including a development agreement entered into under
- 7 <u>Section 212.172; or</u> [-]
- 8 (6) in an area within a municipality's certificate of
- 9 convenience and necessity issued in accordance with Chapter 13,
- 10 Subchapter G, Water Code.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
