1-18 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-19 AN ACT

1-20 relating to the designation of a portion of State Highway 48 in
1-21 Cameron County as the Deputy Constable Ruben Garcia Memorial
1-22 Highway.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
1-25 is amended by adding Section 225.252 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 225.252. DEPUTY CONSTABLE RUBEN GARCIA MEMORIAL
1-27 HIGHWAY. (a) The portion of State Highway 48 in Cameron County
1-28 between its intersection with State Highway 550 and its
1-29 intersection with Fishermans Place Road is designated as the Deputy
1-30 Constable Ruben Garcia Memorial Highway. The designation is in
1-31 addition to any other designation.

1-32 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

1-33 (1) design and construct markers indicating the
1-34 designation as the Deputy Constable Ruben Garcia Memorial Highway
1-35 and any other appropriate information; and

1-36 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
1-37 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-38 SECTION 2. It is the intent of the 89th Legislature, Regular
1-39 Session, 2025, that the provisions added by this Act be renumbered
1-40 to prevent multiple provisions with the same designation.

1-41 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
