## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

 AN ACT	

- 2 relating to prohibitions on lobbyists making certain expenditures
- 3 and gifts to public servants.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 36.10(a), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 (a) Sections 36.08 (Gift to Public Servant) and 36.09
- 8 (Offering Gift to Public Servant) do not apply to:
- 9 (1) a fee prescribed by law to be received by a public
- 10 servant or any other benefit to which the public servant is lawfully
- 11 entitled or for which he gives legitimate consideration in a
- 12 capacity other than as a public servant;
- 13 (2) a gift or other benefit conferred on account of
- 14 kinship or a personal, professional, or business relationship
- 15 independent of the official status of the recipient;
- 16 (3) a benefit to a public servant required to file a
- 17 statement under Chapter 572, Government Code, or a report under
- 18 Title 15, Election Code, that is derived from a function in honor or
- 19 appreciation of the recipient if:
- 20 (A) the benefit and the source of any benefit in
- 21 excess of \$50 is reported in the statement; and
- (B) the benefit is used solely to defray the
- 23 expenses that accrue in the performance of duties or activities in
- 24 connection with the office which are nonreimbursable by the state

- SECTION 2. Section 305.024(a), Government Code, as amended

- 4 SECTION 3. Section 571.064(b), Government Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (b) If a law, other than a law providing an expenditure
- 7 limit for a person required to register under Chapter 305,
- 8 administered and enforced by the commission sets dollar amounts or
- 9 categories of amounts as reporting thresholds or if the commission
- 10 sets those amounts, the commission annually shall adjust those
- 11 thresholds upward to the nearest multiple of \$10 in accordance with
- 12 the percentage increase for the previous year in the Consumer Price
- 13 Index for Urban Consumers published by the Bureau of Labor
- 14 Statistics of the United States Department of Labor.
- 15 SECTION 4. Section 36.10, Penal Code, as amended by this
- 16 Act, applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective
- 17 date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of
- 18 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was
- 19 committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 20 purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed
- 21 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense
- 22 occurred before that date.
- SECTION 5. Section 305.024, Government Code, as amended by
- 24 this Act, applies only to an expenditure made on or after the
- 25 effective date of this Act. An expenditure made before the
- 26 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 27 date the expenditure was made, and the former law is continued in

- 1 effect for that purpose.
- 2 SECTION 6. Section 571.064(b), Government Code, as amended
- 3 by this Act, applies to an adjustment made by the Texas Ethics
- 4 Commission under that subsection before the effective date of this
- 5 Act. The commission shall adopt rules as necessary to reverse each
- 6 adjustment made under that subsection before the effective date of
- 7 this Act that would not have been made if the change in law made by
- 8 this Act had been in effect at the time of the adjustment.
- 9 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
