5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 784.001(5), Health and Safety Code, is
7	amended to read as follows:
8	(5) "Emergency service provider" means an individual
9	who provides emergency response services or post-emergency
10	response services, including:
11	(A) a law enforcement officer;
12	(B) a[7] firefighter;
13	(C) an $[\tau]$ emergency medical services provider;
14	(D) a[7] dispatcher;
15	(E) a[, or] rescue service provider <u>;</u>
16	(F) an attorney, an investigator, or another
17	staff member for the office of a district attorney, criminal
18	district attorney, or county attorney; or
19	(G) a justice of the peace or a staff member for a
20	justice court.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
