7	Sec. 11.006. PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES BY ADMINISTRATORS. (a)
8	In this section, "administrator" means a person who has significant
9	administrative duties relating to the operation of a school
10	district, including the operation of a campus, program, or other
11	subdivision of the district. The term does not include a school
12	district employee whose employment contract responsibilities
13	primarily include the in-classroom instruction of students.
14	(b) An administrator may not receive any financial benefit
15	for the performance of personal services for:
16	(1) any business entity that conducts or solicits
17	business with the school district that employs the administrator;
18	(2) an education business that provides services
19	regarding the curriculum or administration of any school district;
20	or
21	(3) another school district, open-enrollment charter
22	school, or regional education service center.
23	(c) An administrator who violates this section is liable to
24	the state for a civil penalty in the amount of \$10,000 for each

- 2 SECTION 2. Section 11.201(e), Education Code, is repealed.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
