5	SECTION 1. Section $46.01(3)$, Penal Code, is amended to read
6	as follows:

- 7 (3) "Firearm" means any device designed, made, or 8 adapted to expel a projectile through a barrel by using the energy 9 generated by an explosion or burning substance or any device 10 readily convertible to that use. Firearm does not include:
- (A) a firearm that may have, as an integral part,
 12 a folding knife blade or other characteristics of weapons made
 13 illegal by this chapter and that is:
- $\underline{\text{(i)}}$ [(A)] an antique or curio firearm 15 manufactured before 1899; or
- (ii) [(B)] a replica of an antique or curio firearm manufactured before 1899, but only if the replica does not use rim fire or center fire ammunition; or
- 19 <u>(B) a less-lethal projectile device</u>.
- 20 SECTION 2. Section 46.01, Penal Code, is amended by adding 21 Subdivision (21) to read as follows:
- 22 (21) "Less-lethal projectile device" means any
 23 weapon, device, or munition that is designed, made, or adapted to
 24 expel a projectile or multiple projectiles against a target to

- 1 temporarily incapacitate the target while minimizing the risk of
- 2 serious bodily injury or death.
- 3 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 4 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 5 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 6 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 7 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 8 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 9 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 10 before that date.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
