- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 208.002(a), Labor Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) When used in connection with an initial claim, "last
- 8 work" and "person for whom the claimant last worked" refer to  $[\div$
- 9 [(1) the last person for whom the claimant actually
- 10 worked, if the claimant worked for that person for at least 30 hours
- 11 during a week; or
- 12  $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$  the employer, as defined by Subchapter C,
- 13 Chapter 201, [or by the unemployment law of any other state,] for
- 14 whom the claimant last worked, unless otherwise provided by state
- 15 <u>or federal law</u>.
- SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 17 a claim for unemployment compensation benefits filed with the Texas
- 18 Workforce Commission on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 19 claim filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 20 law in effect on the date the claim was filed, and the former law is
- 21 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2026.
