- without a court order, take possession of a child who appears to be 10
- younger than one year [60 days] old [or younger] if: 11
- 12 (1) the child is voluntarily delivered to the provider
- by the child's parent by: 13
- 14 (A) leaving the child with an employee of the
- provider; or 15
- placing the child in a newborn safety device 16 (B)
- located inside the provider's facilities; and 17
- 18 (2) the parent did not express an intent to return for
- the child. 19
- 20 (a-1) A parent who voluntarily delivers the parent's child
- to a designated emergency infant care provider under Subsection (a) 21
- is considered to have voluntarily relinquished the parent's 22
- 23 parental rights to the child.
