8 SECTION 2. Section 478.0053, Government Code, is amended to 9 read as follows:

Sec. 478.0053. EXEMPTION FROM CERTAIN ELIGIBILITY
REQUIREMENT FOR CERTAIN LARGE VENUES. Section 478.0051(b)(1) does
not apply to an event described by Section 478.0001(3)(N) or

(GG-1). If an endorsing municipality or endorsing county requests
the office to make a determination under Section 478.0102 for an

event described by Section 478.0001(3)(N) or (GG-1), the remaining

16 provisions of this chapter apply to that event as if the event

17 satisfied the eligibility requirements under Section

18 478.0051(b)(1).

19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
