A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the generation of electric power by a water supply or
- 3 sewer service corporation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 67, Water Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 67.0115 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 67.0115. ELECTRIC GENERATION. (a) A corporation may
- 8 generate electric power for use in the corporation's operations,
- 9 limited to:
- 10 (1) powering water well pumps, service pumps, and
- 11 other equipment for the production, treatment, and transportation
- 12 of raw water; and
- (2) powering infrastructure for the treatment and
- 14 delivery of potable drinking water.
- 15 (b) For the purposes of Subsection (a), a corporation
- 16 operating solely as a wholesale water supplier or sewer service in a
- 17 county with a population of less than 350,000 may generate excess
- 18 electric power in conjunction with the uses described in Subsection
- 19 (a) for sale in the ERCOT power region to provide revenue for the
- 20 corporation only if the corporation:
- 21 (1) primarily generates electric power solely for the
- 22 uses described in Subsection (a); and
- 23 (2) registers as a power generation company under
- 24 Section 39.351, Utilities Code.

- 1 (c) A corporation that generates electric power for sale
- 2 under Subsection (b) shall account for and use the revenue from
- 3 those sales in a manner that complies with Section 67.004. The
- 4 revenue that accrues from those sales of electric power may be used
- 5 by the corporation only for:
- 6 (1) the corporation's costs of producing and selling
- 7 <u>electric power</u>, including administration, employees, equipment,
- 8 <u>fuel</u>, and maintenance; or
- 9 (2) a purpose described by Section 67.002.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
