- 5 SECTION 1. Section 61.014, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (e) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) Except as permitted by Sections 61.012 and 61.013, a [A]
- 9 person may not use a wireless communication device within a room in
- 10 which voting is taking place [within 100 feet of a voting station].
- (e) The secretary of state shall require a presiding judge
- 12 to post a notice that states the prohibition on the use of a
- 13 wireless communication device in a prominent and reasonably visible
- 14 location outside of a room in which voting is taking place.
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
