- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 654.037, Government Code, is amended by 6 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (e) The classification officer shall:
- 8 (1) identify state agency positions for which the
- 9 educational, experience, and training requirements could be
- 10 reduced to increase the number of qualified applicants who could
- 11 proficiently perform the positions;
- 12 (2) reduce to the extent practicable the number of
- 13 state agency positions requiring an employee to hold a bachelor's
- 14 degree as a condition of employment;
- 15 (3) evaluate ways to expand career advancement
- 16 opportunities for state agency employees who do not hold a
- 17 bachelor's degree; and
- 18 (4) report the information gathered as required by
- 19 this subsection to the governor's budget office and the Legislative
- 20 Budget Board in the time required by Subsection (a)(2).
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
