- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 31A, Code of Criminal
- 6 Procedure, is amended by adding Article 31A.0021 to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 Art. 31A.0021. CHANGE OF VENUE FOR CERTAIN OFFENSES
- 9 COMMITTED BY PEACE OFFICERS. On a motion by the defendant the judge
- 10 shall order a change of venue if the defendant:
- 11 (1) Is a peace officer or was a peace officer at the
- 12 time of the alleged offense; and
- 13 (2) Has been charged with an offense allegedly
- 14 committed under color of the defendant's employment as a peace
- 15 officer.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to a defendant charged with an offense committed on or after the
- 18 effective date of this Act. A defendant charged with an offense
- 19 committed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- 20 law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the former
- 21 law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this
- 22 section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this
- 23 Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
