- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 550.041, Transportation
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 550.041. INVESTIGATION BY PEACE OFFICER OR DESIGNEE OF
- 8 LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 550.041, Transportation Code, is amended
- 10 by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 11 (c) A former peace officer who is designated by a law
- 12 enforcement agency and who has successfully completed a training
- 13 program on investigating motor vehicle collisions approved by the

- SECTION 4. Section 550.062, Transportation Code, is amended

- 3 (a-1) A former peace officer who is designated by a law
- 4 enforcement agency to investigate a motor vehicle collision in

- 6 summarizing the findings of the investigation.
- 7 (b) The report required by Subsection (a) or (a-1) must be
- 8 filed electronically with the department not later than the 10th
- 9 day after the date of the collision.
- 10 (b-1) If the motor vehicle collision involved a combination
- 11 of vehicles operating under a permit issued under Section 623.402,
- 12 the report required by Subsection (a) or (a-1) must include the
- 13 weight and the number of axles of the vehicle combination.
- 14 (c) This section applies without regard to whether the
- 15 officer or former peace officer designated by a law enforcement

- 8 of the person who originated the change.
