- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 66.002(3), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (3) "Harris County port" means a place in Harris $\underline{\text{or}}$
- 8 <u>Chambers</u> County into which a vessel <u>using the Houston Ship Channel</u>
- 9 enters or from which a vessel <u>using the Houston Ship Channel</u>
- 10 departs, and the waterway leading to that place from the Gulf of
- 11 Mexico.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 66.012, Transportation Code, is amended
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 66.012. PROHIBITED INTEREST. A person may not be a
- 15 member of the board if the person, directly or indirectly, is
- 16 engaged in or has an interest in any [pilot boat or in any other]
- 17 business that may adversely affect [affected by or connected with]
- 18 the performance of the person's duties as a pilot commissioner.
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 66.040(b), Transportation Code, is
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- 21 (b) A deputy branch pilot's certificate expires on the
- 22 <u>fourth</u> [third] anniversary of the date it is issued and may [not] be
- 23 renewed <u>as provided by Section 66.042</u>.
- SECTION 4. Section 66.042, Transportation Code, is amended

- 2 Sec. 66.042. DEPUTY BRANCH PILOT'S CERTIFICATE RENEWAL
- 3 [PILOT]. A person who has been issued a deputy branch pilot's
- 4 certificate may apply to renew the certificate if the deputy branch
- 5 pilot is reappointed by a branch pilot as provided by Section 66.038
- 6 [not be issued a deputy branch pilot's certificate before the fifth
- 7 anniversary of the date the person was previously issued a deputy
- 8 branch pilot's certificate].
- 9 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
