8	Sections 251.725, 251.726, 251.727, <u>251.728,</u> 251.73, and 251.80, an
9	authorized voting unit that has exercised or may exercise the right
10	of local option retains the status adopted, whether absolute
11	prohibition or legalization of the sale of alcoholic beverages of
12	one or more of the various types and alcoholic contents on which an
13	issue may be submitted under the terms of Section 501.035, Election
14	Code, until that status is changed by a subsequent local option
15	election in the same authorized voting unit.
16	SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 251, Alcoholic Beverage
17	Code, is amended by adding Section 251.728 to read as follows:
18	Sec. 251.728. CHANGE OF STATUS FOR TERRITORY ANNEXED OR
19	OWNED BY MUNICIPALITIES IN CERTAIN COUNTIES. (a) This section
20	applies only to a municipality that:
21	(1) is wholly located in a county containing a portion
22	of U.S. Highways 60 and 87; and

- 3 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies to an
- 4 area annexed by a municipality before, on, or after the effective
