- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11, Article 49.25, Code of Criminal
- 6 Procedure, is amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) The information relating to the next of kin of a
- 8 decedent is excepted from required public disclosure in accordance
- 9 with Chapter 552, Government Code, but is subject to disclosure
- 10 under subpoena or authority of other law.
- 11 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
- 12 request for information that is received by a governmental body or
- 13 an officer of public information on or after the effective date of
- 14 this Act. A request for information that was received before the
- 15 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 16 date the request was received, and the former law is continued in
- 17 effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
