9	(b) At [The operator must notify the office of the
10	commission oil and gas division district in which an inactive well
11	is located at] least three days before the date on which the
12	operator <u>proposes to conduct</u> [conducts] a fluid level or hydraulic
13	pressure test of <u>an inactive</u> [the] well, the operator must notify:
14	(1) the office of the commission oil and gas division
15	district in which the well is located;
16	(2) any groundwater conservation district any portion
17	of the territory of which is located within three miles of the well;
18	<u>and</u>
19	(3) the owner of the surface estate of the tract of
20	land on which the well is located.
21	(b-1) An operator [and] may not conduct <u>a</u> [the] test <u>under</u>
