## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 5, Property Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 5.0131 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 5.0131. SELLER'S DISCLOSURE REGARDING UNIMPROVED REAL
8	PROPERTY IN FLOODPLAIN. (a) In this section, "floodplain" means an
9	area of land designated by the Federal Emergency Management Agency
10	(FEMA) under the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C.
11	Section 4001 et seq.) to be a special or moderate flood hazard area.
12	(b) A seller of unimproved real property located in this
13	state shall provide to the purchaser of the property a written
14	notice disclosing whether any part of the property is located in a
15	floodplain. The disclosure must be substantially equivalent to the
16	<pre>following:</pre>
17	"(Seller) ( ) is aware or ( ) is not aware that the unimproved
18	real property that you are purchasing is located wholly or partly in
19	a floodplain. A floodplain is an area of land designated by the
20	Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to be a special or
21	moderate flood hazard area. If neither box is checked, you should
22	assume all or part of the property is located in a floodplain."
23	(c) The notice must be delivered by the seller on or before
24	the effective date of an executory contract binding the purchaser

- 1 to purchase the property. If a contract is entered into without the
- 2 seller providing the notice as required by this section, the
- 3 purchaser may terminate the contract for any reason not later than
- 4 the seventh day after the effective date of the contract.
- 5 (d) This section applies to any seller of unimproved real
- 6 property, including a seller who is the developer of the property
- 7 and who sells the property to others for resale.
- 8 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 9 a contract for the sale of real property entered into on or after
- 10 the effective date of this Act. A contract entered into before the
- 11 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 12 date the contract was entered into, and that law is continued in
- 13 effect for that purpose.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
