5 SECTION 1. Section 12.057(c), Education Code, is amended to

7 (c) A campus or program granted a charter under Section

12.052, 12.0521(a)(1), or 12.053 is immune from liability to the 8

9 same extent as a school district, and its employees and volunteers

are immune from liability to the same extent as school district 10

employees and volunteers. A member of the governing body of the 11

campus or program is immune from liability and suit to the same 12

13 extent as a school district trustee.

14 SECTION 2. Subchapter G, Chapter 12, Education Code, is

amended by adding Section 12.2525 to read as follows: 15

16 Sec. 12.2525. IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY AND SUIT. In matters

related to the operation of an adult education program under a 17

charter granted under this subchapter, an eligible entity is immune 18

19 from liability and suit to the same extent as a school district, and

its employees and volunteers are immune from liability and suit to 20

the same extent as school district employees and volunteers. A 21

member of the governing body of the entity is immune from liability 22

23 and suit to the same extent as a school district trustee.

24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
