- 2 relating to regulation by a municipality of a certificate of 3 occupancy.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 214, Local Government
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 214.909 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 214.909. REGULATION OF CERTIFICATES OF OCCUPANCY. (a)
- 8 If a municipality has a record of issuing a certificate of
- 9 occupancy, the municipality shall provide a document acknowledging
- 10 that a certificate of occupancy has been issued by the municipality
- 11 upon request by the owner of a building.
- 12 (b) A municipality may not adopt or enforce an ordinance,
- 13 rule, or other measure that requires a person who requests and
- 14 receives a document described by Subsection (a) to obtain or
- 15 display an original certificate of occupancy.
- 16 (c) A municipality shall consider a document described by
- 17 Subsection (a) sufficient to display in place of an original
- 18 certificate of occupancy.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
