(a) In this section: 8 (1) "Person with a disability" means a person with a 9 physical, intellectual, behavioral, or cognitive impairment 10 resulting in the person's inability to perform the activities of 11 daily life. 12 (2) "Place of public accommodation" means any of the 13 14 following locations: 15 (A) a place of exhibition, entertainment, or 16 gathering, including a movie theater, theater of the dramatic or performing arts, concert hall, auditorium, sports arena or stadium, 17 and convention center; 18 19 (B) a sales or rental establishment comprising at least 40,000 square feet, including a shopping mall and shopping 20 21 center; (C) a place of public display or collection, 22 23 including a museum, library, and gallery; 24 (D) a place of recreation, including a park, zoo,

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1 and amusement park; 2 (E) a public or private primary or secondary school, a public or private institution of higher education, and 3 any other place of education; 4 5 (F) a social service center, including a senior 6 center and homeless shelter; 7 (G) a station or terminal used for specified 8 public transportation, including an airport, train depot, and bus station; and 9 (H) a professional office of a health care 10 11 provider, including a hospital and rehabilitation center. (3) "Public building" means a building or facility 12 used by the public and owned or controlled by this state or a 13 14 political subdivision of this state. 15 (4) "Universal changing facility" means an enclosed family or assisted use toilet facility not designated by gender and 16 17 designed for use by a person with a disability, with the assistance of the person's care provider, for personal hygiene purposes. 18 (b) This section applies only to a place of public 19 accommodation or public building: 20 21 (1) that is constructed on or after January 1, 2026; or (2) for which a building permit application is 22 submitted on or after January 1, 2026, for renovation of its main 23 24 facility, not including a parking garage or other parking area, with an estimated cost of at least \$50,000. 25 26 (c) A person with control over the restrooms and changing facilities in a place of public accommodation or public building 27

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1 (1) would result in an undue financial burden on the 2 owner; or 3 (2) is not possible due to the available space at the 4 place or building. 5 SECTION 2. (a) Not later than December 1, 2025, the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt the rules 6 required by Section 341.070, Health and Safety Code, as added by 7 this Act. 8 (b) This section takes effect September 1, 2025. 9

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SECTION 3. Except as otherwise provided by this Act, this
Act takes effect January 1, 2026.

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
