5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 434, Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 434.0261 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 434.0261. ELECTRONIC DATABASE OF CONTACT INFORMATION
9	FOR SERVICE MEMBERS LEAVING ACTIVE DUTY. (a) The commission shall
10	establish and maintain an electronic database that includes the
11	name and contact information of each member of the United States
12	armed forces who:
13	(1) has provided written consent to the commission to
14	have the member's information included in the database; and
15	(2) will be discharged or released from active duty
16	within 12 months of the date the member provides the consent
17	described by Subdivision (1).
18	(b) The database established under Subsection (a) must
19	allow state agencies and local veteran service organizations,
20	including veterans county service offices, that have applied to and
21	been approved by the commission to access the database for the
22	purpose of providing to members of the United States armed forces
23	included in the database information regarding state and local
24	benefits and resources available to veterans, including

- 1 information regarding employment and training opportunities,
- 2 housing, entrepreneurial and health care services, and veteran
- 3 support groups.
- 4 (c) The commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement
- 5 and administer this section, including rules establishing the
- 6 procedure by which entities apply to and are approved by the
- 7 <u>commission to access the database established under Subsection</u> (a).
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
