- 7 (1) "Commission" means the Health and Human Services

- 9 (2) "Executive commissioner" means the executive
- 10 commissioner of the commission.
- 11 (b) As soon as practicable after the effective date of this
- 12 Act, the commission shall employ a language access coordinator to
- 13 conduct an assessment of and identify gaps in non-English speakers'
- 14 access to the health and human services programs administered by
- 15 the commission and 2-1-1 services provided by the Texas Information
- 16 and Referral Network.
- 17 (c) Not later than the first anniversary of the date the
- 18 commission employs a language access coordinator under Subsection
- 19 (b) of this section, the coordinator shall conduct the assessment
- 20 described by that subsection and submit to the executive
- 21 commissioner a written report that:
- 22 (1) summarizes the findings of the assessment; and
