A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to a study conducted by the Texas Division of Emergency
- 3 Management regarding the process for obtaining disaster-related
- 4 financial assistance.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "division" means the
- 7 Texas Division of Emergency Management.
- 8 SECTION 2. STUDY. (a) The division, with the assistance of
- 9 the Emergency Management Council, shall conduct a study on the
- 10 process for applying for, approving, and awarding financial
- 11 assistance during the disaster recovery process.
- 12 (b) In conducting the study, the division shall:
- 13 (1) compile data regarding the amount of time and
- 14 effort required for local governments, individuals, and businesses
- 15 to apply for and ultimately receive disaster-related financial
- 16 assistance;
- 17 (2) identify current laws and rules governing the
- 18 provision of disaster-related financial assistance; and
- 19 (3) identify opportunities to streamline, simplify,
- 20 and expedite the process for local governments, individuals, and
- 21 businesses to apply for and receive disaster-related financial
- 22 assistance.
- SECTION 3. REPORT. Not later than December 1, 2026, the
- 24 division shall submit to the governor, the lieutenant governor, the

- 1 speaker of the house of representatives, and each member of the
- 2 legislature a written report that includes:
- 3 (1) a summary of the information compiled in the
- 4 study, including an analysis of the efficiency and effectiveness of
- 5 the disaster-related financial assistance system; and
- 6 (2) recommendations from the division and the
- 7 Emergency Management Council, including:
- 8 (A) recommendations regarding the manner by
- 9 which disaster-related financial assistance can be provided more
- 10 efficiently, simply, and quickly; and
- 11 (B) recommendations for legislative or other
- 12 action.
- SECTION 4. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act expires September 1,
- 14 2027.
- SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September
- 16 1, 2025.
