## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the Breakthrough Program.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 33, Education Code, is amended by adding
5	Subchapter H to read as follows:
6	SUBCHAPTER H. BREAKTHROUGH PROGRAM
7	Sections 33.261, 33.262, 33.263, 33.264, 33.265 and 33.266
8	Education Code, are added to read as follows:
9	Sec. 33.261 DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
10	(a) "Breakthrough" means a Postsecondary Advising
11	Program that supports students who are the first in their families
12	to pursue and attain a postsecondary certificate or diploma, or
13	students who are eligible for free or reduced-price lunch.
14	Sec. 33.262. DUTIES OF COMMISSIONER. (a) The commissioner
15	shall:
16	(1) coordinate the efforts of the Breakthrough program
17	with other social service organizations and agencies and with
18	<pre>public school personnel to provide services to students who are at</pre>
19	risk of not completing critical steps to complete high school and
20	pursue college and career options after graduation;
21	(2) support the Breakthrough program to establish
22	performance goals, objectives, and measures for the program,
23	including performance goals, objectives, and measures that
24	consider improvement in student:

1	(A) <u>academic achievement;</u>
2	(B) promotion, graduation, and retention; and
3	(C) <u>matriculation</u> into postsecondary education
4	(3) obtain information to determine accomplishment of
5	performance goals, objectives, and measures;
6	(4) help communities that want to participate in the
7	<pre>program establish a local funding base;</pre>
8	(5) provide training and technical assistance for
9	<pre>participating communities and programs;</pre>
10	(6) and adopt policies concerning:
11	(A) the responsibility of the agency in
12	Encouraging local businesses to participate in local Breakthrough
13	programs;
14	(B) the responsibility of the agency in Obtaining
15	information from participating programs; and
16	(C) any other areas concerning the program.
17	Identified by the commissioner.
18	(b) The commissioner shall adopt rules to implement the
19	policies described by Subsection (a)(7) and shall annually update
20	the rules.
21	Sec. 33.263. COOPERATION WITH BREAKTHROUGH. (a) The
22	agency and Breakthrough shall work together to maximize the
23	effectiveness of the Breakthrough program.
24	Sec. 33.264. FUNDING. (a) The agency shall support local
25	Breakthrough programs to develop and implement.
26	(b) Each local Breakthrough program shall develop a funding

- 2 (c) A local Breakthrough program may accept federal funds,
- 3 state funds, private contributions, grants, and public and school
- 4 district funds to support the program.
- 5 Sec. 33.265. AGENCY PERFORMANCE OF BREAKTHROUGH FUNCTIONS
- 6 REQUIRED. (a) The agency, through the Breakthrough State Office:
- 7 (1) <u>must perform each function concerning the</u>
- 8 Breakthrough program for which the agency is responsible; and
- 9 (2) may not contract with a private entity to perform a
- 10 <u>function described by Subdivision (1).</u>
- 11 SECTION 33.266. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
