- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 51.306 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 51.306. AWARD OF UNDERGRADUATE FOREIGN LANGUAGE COURSE
- 9 CREDIT FOR DUAL CREDIT COMPUTER SCIENCE COURSE. (a) In this
- 10 section, "institution of higher education" has the meaning assigned
- 11 by Section 61.003.
- 12 (b) An institution of higher education shall award to an
- 13 undergraduate student enrolled in the institution undergraduate
- 14 course credit toward satisfaction of a foreign language course
- 15 requirement of the institution for the student's successful
- 16 completion of a dual credit course in computer science.
- 17 (c) This section does not apply if the student's major is in
- 18 a foreign language.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 51.306, Education Code, as added by this
- 20 Act, applies beginning with students initially enrolling in an
- 21 undergraduate program at a public institution for the 2025-2026
- 22 academic year.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
