A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the route designation for the issuance of a permit for
- 3 the movement of oversize and overweight vehicles that serve a
- 4 deepwater seaport on the U.S.-Mexico Border.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 623.219(a), Transportation Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) For a permit issued by a port authority located in a
- 9 county that borders the United Mexican States, the commission
- 10 shall, with the consent of the port authority, designate the most
- 11 direct route [from]:
- 12 (1) <u>between</u> the Gateway International Bridge or the
- 13 Veterans International Bridge at Los Tomates to the entrance of the
- 14 Port of Brownsville using State Highways 48 and 4 or United States
- 15 Highways 77 and 83 or using United States Highway 77 and United
- 16 States Highway 83, East Loop Corridor, and State Highway 4; and
- 17 (2) <u>between</u> the Free Trade International Bridge <u>and</u>
- 18 [to]:

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- 19 (A) the entrance of the Port of Brownsville using
- 20 Farm-to-Market Road 509, United States Highways 77 and 83,
- 21 Farm-to-Market Road 511, State Highway 550, and East Loop (State
- 22 Highway 32)
- 23 SECTION 2. This bill is applicable only to the designated
- 24 routes for the Port of Brownsville.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
