- 2 relating to the criminal offense of disrupting a meeting or

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.05(a), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 (a) A person commits an offense if, with intent to prevent
- 8 or disrupt a lawful meeting, procession, or gathering, whether in
- 9 person or virtual, the person [he] obstructs or interferes with the
- 10 meeting, procession, or gathering by:
- 11 (1) physical action;
- 12 <u>(2)</u> [or] verbal utterance; or
- 13 (3) electronic disturbance, including hacking, of any
- 14 virtual component of the meeting, procession, or gathering.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 18 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 19 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 20 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 21 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 22 before that date.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
