- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 16.092, Election Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 16.092. SWORN STATEMENT REQUIRED. A voter desiring to
- 8 challenge a registration must file with the registrar a sworn
- 9 statement of the grounds for the challenge that:
- 10 (1) identifies the voter whose registration is being
- 11 challenged; and
- 12 (2) states a specific qualification for registration
- 13 that the challenged voter has not met based on:
- 14 (A) the personal knowledge of the voter desiring
- 15 to challenge the registration; or
- 16 (B) a fact not subject to reasonable dispute
- 17 because the fact is generally known or can be determined from a
- 18 <u>reliable source</u>.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
