5	SECTION 1. Chapter 773, Health and Safety Code, is amended
6	by adding the following section:
7	SECTION 773.055 EXTENSION OF NON-CERTIFIED DRIVING
8	WAIVERS: (a) Any existing state waivers or emergency orders that
9	allow non-certified individuals to serve as drivers for emergency
10	medical services operations in partnership with state-certified
11	emergency medical technicians and paramedics shall continue
12	without requirements of variance requests after initial approval.
13	(b) Any state waivers or emergency orders that allow
14	non-certified individuals to serve as drivers for emergency medical
15	services operations in partnership with state-certified emergency
16	medical technicians and paramedics approved after the effective
17	date of this Act shall continue without requirements of variance
18	requests.
19	(c) The Texas Department of State Health Services may issue
20	rules to comply with this Act to ensure that providers understand
21	updated requirements with the certification.

SECTION 2. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Act takes effect September
